## Miami Beach Chamber's 27<sup>th</sup> Annual "Golf Classic" Proves to be Successful, Raising More Funding for the Local Community

Over the years, proceeds from the golf tournament have also funded over \$200,000 worth of programming costs for the International Baccalaureate (IB) program. This program, available at

all the public schools in the City of Miami Beach feeder pattern, helps develop the intellectual, personal, emotional and social skills of students from age 3 to 19 and gives them the necessary tools to live, learn and work in a rapidly globalizing world.
